EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 04-2016

REORGANIZATION OF THE MUNICIPAL PEACE AND ORDER COUNCIL (MPOC)

WHEREAS, Article 185, Rule XXIII of the local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160) mandates that a Local Peace and Order Council be established in every municipality;

WHEREAS, the Office of the President issued Executive Order No. 773 dated January 05, 2009 further reorganizing the Peace and Order Council in the municipal level;

WHEREAS, the Order aims to put to rest the human rights' disruption and violation so that the nation can move ahead;

WHEREAS, the local government unit of Calatagan, Batangas believes that the reorganization will be of great help in the maintenance of peace and order in the locality;

NOW, THEREFORE, premises considered and by virtue of the powers vested in me by laws, I, **PETER OLIVER M. PALACIO**, Municipal Mayor of Calatagan, Batangas hereby order that:

SECTION 1. Further Reorganization of the Municipal Peace and Order Council (MPOC). The Municipal Peace and Order Council of Calatagan is hereby further reorganized and the same shall be composed of the following:

SECTION 2. Duties and Responsibilities of the Council.


1. Provide a forum for dialogue and deliberation of major issues and problems affecting peace and order, including insurgency;
2. Recommend measures which will improve or enhance peace and order and public safety in their respective areas of responsibility, including anti-insurgency measures;
3. Initiate and/or oversee the convergence and the orchestration of internal security operations efforts of civil authorities and agencies, military and police;
4. Apply moral suasion to and/or recommend sanctions against local chief executives who are giving material and political support to the Communist rebels;
5. Monitor the provision of livelihood and infrastructure development programs and projects in the remote rural and indigenous population areas adopted to isolate them from the Communist rebels' "Agitate/Arouse, Organize and Mobilize" and ideological, political and organization works;
6. Perform such other functions which may be assigned by higher level peace and order councils.

SECTION 3. There shall be a Peace and Order Secretariat which shall handle the administrative and technical activities of the Peace and Order Council that is organized in the various administrative levels of government. The Secretariat shall also undertake liaising and coordination of activities with appropriate agencies of the government. For this purpose, **Mr. Franz Allen C. Adel**, MLGOO is the head of the Secretariat.

SECTION 4. Repealing Clause. All prior issuances on the organization and functions of the Municipal Peace and Order Council inconsistent herewith shall be deemed superseded by this Order.

SECTION 5. Effectivity. This Order shall take effect immediately.
